Pakistan Afghanistan Joint Chamber of Commerce & Industry: A Profile

The formation of Pakistan-Afghanistan Joint Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PAJCCI) is a breath of fresh air for both the countries. Despite existing political upheavals and sensitive socio-cultural issues, the push for economic collaboration from business community across the border has always been explicit. The economic platforms are eagerly rethinking their bilateral relationship and discussions are underway with respect to reviving the economic ties, curtailing smuggling and preventing flow of prohibited goods. This pressing need was sensed by business representatives in both the countries and they mutually agreed to establish a cooperative body on a private initiative in order to bring the business communities of the two countries closer together.

Pakistan Afghanistan Joint Chamber of Commerce & Industry (PAJCCI) is a joint collaboration between Karachi Chamber of Commerce (KCCI), Chaman Chamber of Commerce (CCCI), Khyber Pakhtoonkhwa Chamber of Commerce (KPCCI) and Afghanistan Chamber of Commerce (ACCI). The entity is duly recognized and licensed by Islamic Republic of Afghanistan as well as Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

The core objective of this trans-border arrangement is not only to transform the economic landscape of the South and Central Asian region but also to facilitate peace prospects and to curb extremism and terrorism. The Chamber was established having members of Business and Industrial community with a motive to provide level playing field for promoting the bi-lateral trade and investment, ensuring transfer of technology, exploring new trade opportunities and areas of mutual interests, alleviating illegal trade and promoting positive image of both the countries across the globe.

It would also be a catalyst to easing out any pressures induced by Political or Legal framework in the respective countries in the most appropriate manner possible. It was agreed between the two sides to ease trade between the two countries and all problems or hurdles are done away with. It was also decided to resolve the issue in board amicably and then put forward to respective governments. It was agreed mutually that this platform will not only resolve trade based issues amicably but would strategize on the macro-level to facilitate respective Governments to revive bi-lateral political relationship as well, in the greater interest of both the countries.

Under the visionary leadership of Mr. Khan Jan Alkozai (President, PAJCCI) and Mr. Muhammad Zubair Motiwala (Co-President, PAJCCI), the Chamber will facilitate Pakistan to gain access to the Central Asian States via Afghanistan and would further enhance the trade opportunities. The Chamber will serve to ensure win-win situation for all stakeholders and will serve as a body to enhance trade relations between two brotherly nations without succumbing to any unrelated political or cultural influence.

PAJCCI Achievements in a Glimpse December 2013

Pakistan Afghanistan Joint Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PAJCCI), duly recognized and licensed by Islamic Republic of Afghanistan as well as Islamic Republic of Pakistan. It was a result of collaborative efforts of Karachi Chamber of Commerce & Industry (KCCI), Afghanistan Chamber of Commerce & Industry (ACCI), Khyber Pakhtoonkhwa Chamber of Commerce & Industry (KPCCI) and Chaman Chamber of Commerce & Industry (CCCI). It is also important to highlight that British High Commission and Center for International Private Enterprises (CIPE) have played significant role in its formation and are important partner in the project.

PAJCCI has its two main offices, one in Karachi and other in Kabul. PAJCCI's offices started functioning since February 2012 by induction of Secretary General / Executive Director in both Karachi and Kabul. PAJCCI- Pakistan now has its two regional offices one in Peshawar and other in Chaman.

The first board meeting of PAJCCI was held in March 2012, in which board composition was determined. There are eleven members each as directors on board from each chapter. As per mutual consensus, the elected leadership would be on rotational basis, one year from Pakistan and another year from Afghanistan. For the first year, President has been elected from Pakistan and Co-President from Afghanistan. The Board unanimously elected Mr. Muhammad Zubair Motiwala as the President and Mr. Khan Jan Alokozai as Co-President. In September 2013, the leadership has been moved to Afghanistan and now our President is Mr. Khan Jan Alokozai and Co-President is Mr. Muhammad Zubair Motiwala.

The core objective of this Chamber is to facilitate peace prospects and strengthen economic and trade ties between the two brotherly nations, Pakistan and Afghanistan. It would also be a catalyst to easing out any pressures induced by Political or Legal framework in the respective countries in the most appropriate manner possible. It was agreed between the two sides to ease trade between the two countries and all problems / hurdles are done away with. It was also decided to resolve the issue in board amicably and then put forward to respective governments. It would also strengthen main stream trade from a parallel trade and will open ancient silk route to CIS countries.

Till date, under visionary leadership, PAJCCI has been able to attain the following in a very short span of time:

- First Trade Delegation arrived from Afghanistan in July 2012. At this point, PAJCCI met Mr. Munir Qureshi, Secretary, Ministry of Commerce at a Dinner Meeting to deliberate upon mutual transit issues and resolutions for improvement in bi-lateral ties. The delegation was also invited by Honorable Chief Minister, Sindh where issues of common interest were discussed.
- APTTA document was only available in English whereby most of the stakeholders either speak Urdu or Pashto, therefore PAJCCI took initiative and translated this critical document in Urdu, Dari and Pashto and made it readily available online on PAJCCI's website.




- A meeting of stakeholders was conducted to review APTTA 2010 agreement in September 2012 to prepare draft to be presented to ministries in both the countries for improvement in the agreement. The same draft was first discussed in PAJCCI's meeting and later presented at an APTCCA meeting in October 2012 as a basis for 8 most important unanimous resolutions.
- 31 member hi level delegation visited Afghanistan in October 2012, whereby PAJCCI's Executive body met all relevant ministries and officials in Afghanistan including Ministry of Commerce-Afghanistan, AISA, US embassy, USAID etc.
- During the visit to Kabul in October 2012 and in PAJCCI's 3rd Board Meeting, APTTA was critically discussed and 8 most important resolutions were agreed upon mutually to resolve long pending issues between the business community across the border. The same were presented in APTTCA meeting in October 2012, and few of the most important resolutions were also agreed upon by Ministry of Commerce of both the countries.
- In its efforts to further develop the baseline to enhance trade and investment between the two countries, first Joint Business Perception Survey was initiated and completed in December 2012. The International Edition of the Survey was launched on January 2,2013 at the Economic Cooperation Conference organized by PAJCCI in Islamabad. Recently English and Urdu version are printed and circulated whereas Dari and Pashto versions are under process and will be circulated amongst all stakeholders shortly.
- In January 2013, an Economic Cooperation Conference was organized in Islamabad whereby all related officials and ministries across the border were invited. The conference was based on the resultants acquired in the survey and became platform for inter-ministerial discussions and deliberations.
- In January 2013, PAJCCI delegation also met H.E. Prime Minister Pakistan for the brief and from that meeting most important issues, like case of stranded containers of Afghan transit trade, were immediately resolved. During the stay, PAJCCI and Afghan officials also had several meetings with the related Pakistani officials for better coordination and interaction in future.
- Since its establishment in February 2012, PAJCCI is aggressively pursuing its goal to ensure B2B linkages between the business communities across the border. The exchange of delegation and an Annual Conference became very vital platforms, where businessmen from different sectors across the border interested in capitalizing business opportunities interacted. These initiatives are a leap forward in enhancement of bi-lateral ties between the two neighboring countries.
- PAJCCI continues to participate at different forums like KPIT, Health Asia, My Karachi 2013, Expo Pakistan etc. for better networking and membership enhancement. PAJCCI has also acquired membership of International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) for better representation internationally.



- Advisory role of PAJCCI is now well established where both Chapters under leadership of President and Co-President ensures settlement of critical issues amongst the business entities across the border. Similarly coordination with ministries, custom officials and related consulates / embassies is increasing whereby they also facilitate resolution of issues. In recent past, several SROs were issued resolving problems of business community upon intervention of PAJCCI. USAID, US embassy and BHC also very keenly follow-up PAJCCI's activities in this context.
- PAJCCI has again revisited APTTA 2010 in August 2013 to present actual scenario to Ministry of Commerce and FBR. This document was very wellreceived by ministries of both the sides in recent APTTCA meeting held at Kabul in October 2013.
- PAJCCI has been contacted by several chambers for collaboration and other international embassies to have tri-partite arrangements. In this context, PAJCCI as a first step has launched its institutional membership and intends to grow its reach an d coverage.
- In September 2013, 3rd trade delegation arrived from Afghanistan that visited PAJCCI booth at Expo Pakistan and was engaged in a B2B meeting organized by PAJCCI amongst business community across the border. The meeting was also attended by delegation of UKPCCI led by its President, Mr. Razi Khan. The delegation was in Karachi since September 25-29, 2013.
- PAJCCI, keeping its legacy, has conducted 2nd Joint Trade Survey by inculcating feedback of the trading and business communities along with officials and ministries across the border.
- Fourth Trade Delegation of PAJCCI is visiting Kabul during December 23-26, 2013. On the basis of the resultant from 2nd Trade Survey, PAJCCI will conduct its 2nd Annual Conference on Bilateral Opportunities during the same visit where ministries and related officials will participate and deliberate upon issues of common interests.
- PAJCCI is very serious to follow-up on its advisory activities across the country and some joint activities so that resolution of stakeholders is attained.
- PAJCCI is technological in its approach, from emails and corporate sms service to an updated website is its clear focus. We are also present professionally at social media and upcoming target is to establish user-friendly website whereby our services would be delivered in an interactive mode.

This unique international chamber is focused on ensuring economic stability and enhancing prospects for bilateral relations between the two nations. We, as a team, aspire to become self-sustainable and more proactive in extending the support to business community in both the countries.
